Good evening! We wanted to give you an update on our schedule for the remainder of the first semester. As you are aware, Governor Beshear has previously signed an executive order that closes all middle and high schools until January 4th. In addition, elementary schools were given permission to return to in-person instruction only if the county is no longer in red on the state map when released on the previous Thursday. On today's map, Pike County continues to be red, and therefore we will be unable to return students to in-person instruction based upon this order. For that reason, and for the purpose of giving students and families consistency, all Pikeville Independent students will remain on RED (all-virtual) until January 4th. We await further guidance from the Governor's office about the options that will be available to us at that point, and will communicate that as soon as possible.
