## MIDDLE SCHOOL HOLDBACK POLICY

#### **POLICY STATEMENT**

Students wishing to voluntarily hold back for the next school year must submit the official declaration form signed by all parents/guardians by May 1 of the current school year. No requests will be taken after this time. August 1 is the deadline to rescind the declaration.

Students wishing to hold back in 8th grade may not turn 15 prior to Aug 1 of the 2nd 8th grade year.

Students who are holding back must take all state and district level assessments required of the grade level they are repeating and will be assigned a class schedule appropriate to the repeated grade level.

Students will be allowed to participate in all middle school level extra-curricular activities during the voluntary holdback year including, but not limited to: Fall league academic team competition, sports, and clubs.

\*Special Note–Students who are retained due to academic deficiencies *may not participate* in sports during the grade they are repeating due to academic ineligibility. A student who is in danger of being retained due to academic deficiencies may not declare a voluntary hold back to circumvent the retention.

Voluntary holdbacks may be ruled ineligible from all activities by administration due to behavioral concerns.

# Participation in High School Athletics

Per KHSAA, voluntary hold back students 7th - 8th may not compete in JV or Varsity high school athletics in the year they are repeating.

# Participation in KAAC Governor's Cup:

Per KAAC (Kentucky Association for Academic Competition), once promoted to grade six (6), students have seven (7) consecutive years of eligibility for KAAC events; three (3) consecutive years at the Middle Grades level, and four (4) consecutive years at the High School level.
