STUDENTS THAT DRIVE TO PIKEVILLE HIGH SCHOOL MUST ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Each driver must have an application on file in the principal's office with a copy of his/her driver's license and proof of insurance.
2. All riders in the car must have permission forms signed by their parents to ride with the driver in his/her car.
3. Speeding or reckless driving will result in the loss of driving privileges.
4. All students must park their cars in the designated area.
5. Each car should be parked in a manner that no other cars are blocked.
6. Students are not to sit in cars after arriving on school grounds. Drivers and riders shall report to the school building immediately.
7. Students are not allowed to leave school grounds after arrival without permission from the office.
8. Students are not allowed to go to their cars during the school day.
9. Driving privileges may be revoked because of disciplinary problems.
10. Vehicles parked on the Pikeville High School campus are subject to be searched for reasonable cause by the administration or the local police.
11. Any student that drives to Pikeville High School will be required to participate in the random drug testing program. Failure to have a signed consent form on file will result in immediate loss of driving privilege.
12. Pikeville High School and the Pikeville Independent Board of Education are not responsible for any vehicle damage in the student parking lot.

*Violations of the above rules will result in loss of driving privileges. The **first offense** will result in a 5 day loss of driving privileges. A **second offense** will result in 10 day loss of driving privileges. A **third offense** will result in loss of driving privileges for the remainder of the school year. Students who drive to school while driving privileges are revoked are subject to a short-term suspension (1 to 5 days).*
